

## Nor-Gwyn Pool Rules and Regulations

The rules below are designed to promote a welcoming and safe environment for all patrons and guests:

1. Be respectful of our facility and courteous to everyone. Please obey the lifeguards and management staff.
2. Your membership ID card is required for admittance each time you enter/re-enter the pool grounds. ID cards are not transferrable. Access to the pool without your ID card is subject to a \$2 per family service charge.
3. Members' guests must register at the front booth and wear a wristband for the day. Sponsoring members must accompany their guests while at the pool.
4. Children under 12 must be accompanied – and monitored – by a responsible caretaker over 16.
5. NO GLASS CONTAINERS are permitted inside the facility at any time. Management reserves the right to inspect coolers and bags entering the facility.
6. No alcoholic beverages, smoking or vaping on Township property or within the facility.
7. No pop-up or other tent-like structures greater than 36" high (infant size) are permitted. No umbrellas except those designed to be attached to a chair are allowed.
8. Please WALK while on paved surfaces. Horseplay in the pool, on the WIBITs, or on the decks is not permitted.
9. Shade umbrellas may ONLY be opened/closed by staff members. Do not hang or attach anything to umbrellas.
10. Parents of children in a swim class or team practice must stay outside the fence or under the baby pool pavillion. Speak to the teachers/coaches before or after class ONLY.
11. Only Coast Guard-approved (non-inflatable) flotation devices are permitted, and may only be used in the shallow end, with an accompanying parent in the water. Flotation devices are not permitted on slides/WIBITs.
12. No fins, mermaid tails, or other such devices are permitted.
13. Persons who have had a contagious illness (e.g.: pink eye or stomach/intestinal virus) within a 24-hour period are not permitted in the pool. Persons with Covid-19 must follow public health quarantine guidelines.
14. Swim diapers are required for infants and toddlers who are not toilet trained.
15. Pets are not permitted on the premises except for select events.
16. Youth must pass swim tests for access to slides, deep end of the pool, diving boards or WIBITs. For slide use, one must be able to swim 25 meters unassisted, not touching the bottom or walls. For deep water, diving boards and all WIBITs, one must be able to swim 25 meters of continuous front crawl using bilateral breathing without touching the floor or wall. Youth must wear their swim test wristband at the pool to use the related equipment. There is a fee for lost wristbands. Slide, WIBIT and Deep-water privileges may be revoked if the child requires guard assistance or is unable to use the equipment on his/her own.
17. Jumps or dives off the diving board must be straight forward (not to the side), one bounce is permitted. One person on the diving board at a time, wait until the person in front of you exits the pool before diving, exit the pool at the ladder closest to the diving board, do not touch the fulcrum (rotating wheel) on the board.
18. Proper swim attire is required when in the pools (no street clothes). Those who cannot wear traditional swim suits are required to wear swim attire made of synthetic, swim-suit material (lycra, nylon, etc.)
19. Ball throwing is limited to the grassy areas away from other patrons. No hard balls may be used at any time.
20. Any behavior endangering yourself or others or disturbing other patrons is not permitted.

WIBIT rules are posted on the bulletin board.

In the event of any combination of the following, management reserves the right to limit the number of members or guests or close the facility: low/high attendance, bad weather, staffing availability and private events.

By entering the facility, you are agreeing to these Rules and Regulations – as interpreted by the pool management. The staff reserves the right to enforce additional rules or prohibit any activity not mentioned above to ensure the safety, comfort, and security of all.

**ANYONE VIOLATING THESE RULES MAY BE ASKED TO LEAVE THE FACILITY AND MAY LOSE THEIR MEMBERSHIP.**
